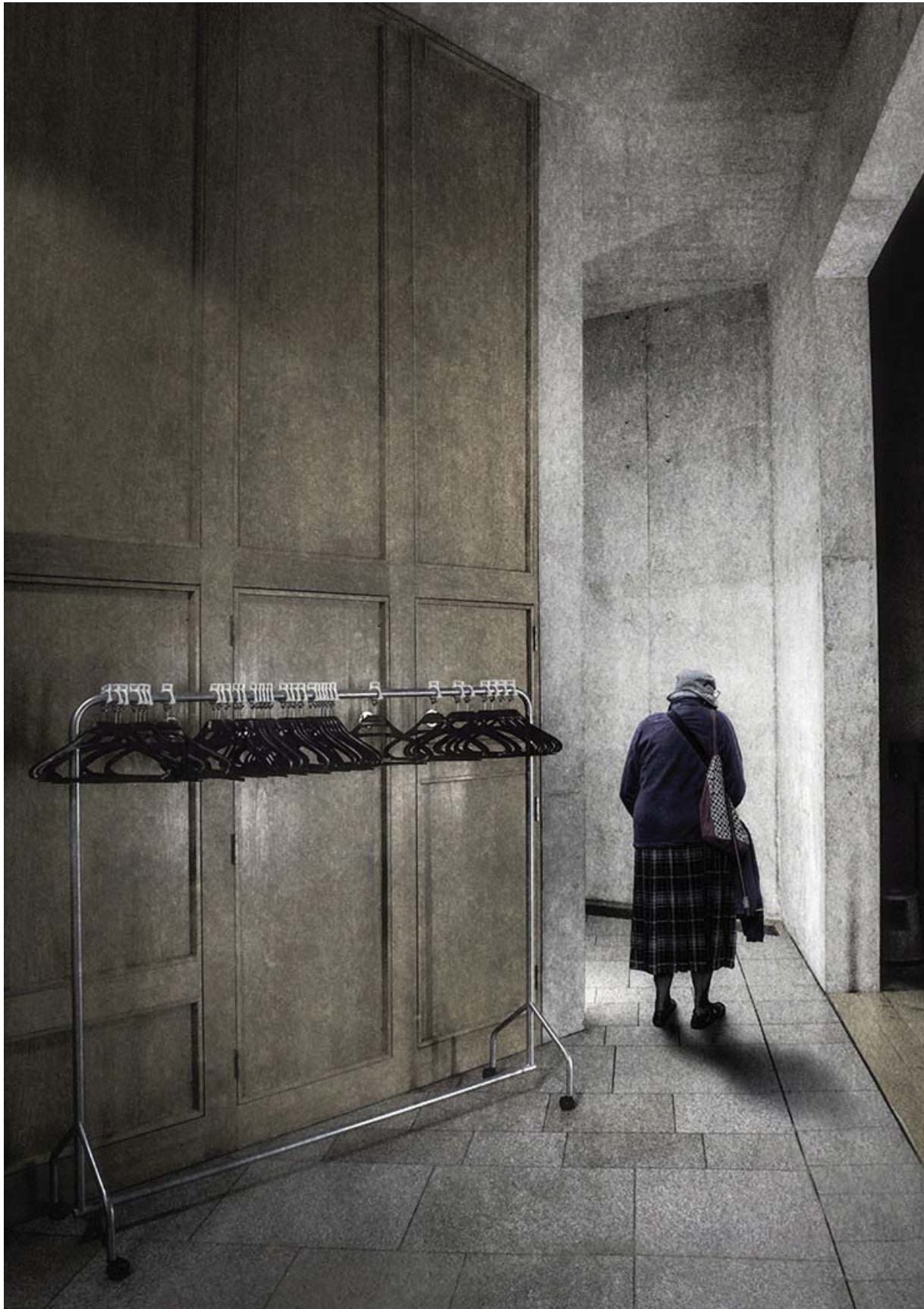

FIAP DISTINCTIONS

TIMETABLE FOR THE 2019 SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

The PDF file "Admissions Timetable", for those who have achieved the criteria and wish to apply for a Distinction, has been posted on the PAGB web site at - <http://www.thepagb.org.uk/fiap/fiap-distinctions/>. Downloadable PDF files, "Criteria for FIAP Awards", setting out the required criteria for the various distinctions, and an "FAQ file", as well as the guidance document "Working towards Distinctions" are available on the same page and these have all been updated from last year.

Note. These instructions do not apply to Members of the Scottish Photographic Federation & Welsh Photographic Federation. They are separately affiliated to FIAP with their own FIAP Liaison Officers. Applications for FIAP Distinctions in those Federations cannot be processed by the PAGB.

AFIAP/EFIAP and EFIAP Levels Applications

Registration for AFIAP, EFIAP or EFIAP Levels will open on

Monday 14th November 2018

and

MFIAP Applications

Anyone interested in applying for MFIAP should contact me by e-mail at an early stage, before starting on your entry. Include your full Name, Address with Post Code, Telephone number with all the other details required and I will forward you an "Applications Package".

The final date for the full applications to reach me is -

Friday 15th December 2017

FIAP now requires everyone applying for a Distinction to hold a **FIAP Photographer's Life Card**.

There is a very substantive change to the process of obtaining FIAP Life Cards.

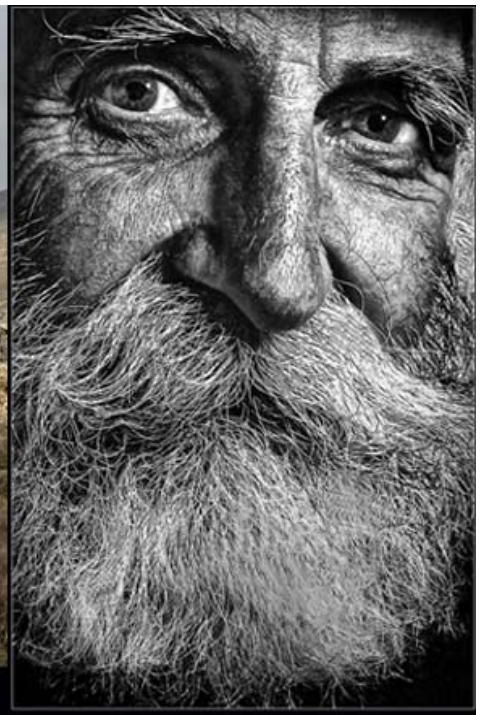
Now this will have to be done, by you, using the FIAP Platform. There is a charge of €50 plus postage and PayPal charges

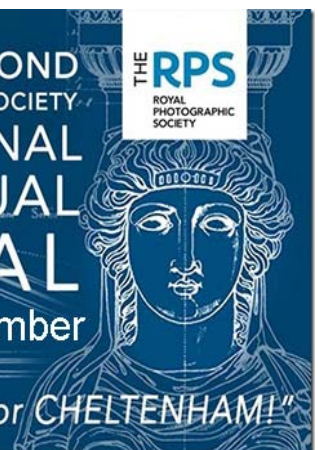

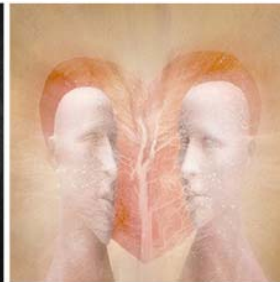

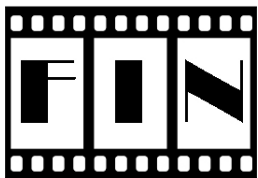
